The AgriBioscience campus is a partnership between the Government of Victoria and La Trobe University. Site Visit 5	Waste	<p>The issue of food waste is a significant one, with costly consequences for the entire supply chain. Waste to energy: On this tour, participants will visit the Yarra Valley Water facility in Mitcham to see how food waste from airlines, commercial suppliers and wholesale fruit and vegetable markets can be turned into energy. The Yarra Valley facility processes up to 33,000 tonnes of food waste each year, which is enough to power around 2,000 homes.</p> <p>Waste to product: More and more businesses are looking at new ways of converting food waste to product. Victorian gin distillers Four Pillars is one such company.
